

Middletown Middle School Eighth Grade Materials List for 2009-2010

EACH STUDENT MUST PURCHASE AN AGENDA FROM MMS.

Due to the large numbers of students and staff in the hallways, students may not bring suitcases or book bags on wheels. They do not fit inside lockers and they create a safety issue to everyone. MMS will provide comparable school supplies for any student that cannot purchase his/her own supplies. Students will purchase an agenda (homework planner) from MMS.

All 8th grade students will need the following supplies:

Loose-leaf notebook paper

Graph paper

3-ring binders, one for each class: Language Arts, Math, Science

Section dividers for 3-ring binders: Language Arts-5, Math-3

Spiral notebooks, one for each class: Math, Science, Social Studies, Health

Pocket folders: Math-1, Social Studies-2, Health-1.

3 x 5 index cards: two packs for Social Studies

#2 Pencils

Erasable ink pens, blue or black

Colored pencils

Red pen

Highlighter

Eraser

Glue stick

The 8th grade team does not require or encourage trapper keepers.

*Eighth graders will pay \$1 to cover the cost of a lock rental. All 8th graders will be required to use a school lock.

The following items are needed for the classes listed below:

Physical Education: Lock rental fee is \$1. We require P.E. clothing to be a gray or orange shirt and black shorts. These items will be available for purchase at the beginning of the year. A change of sneakers and socks is also encouraged. Also, bring a sweatshirt and sweatpants for cold weather. For the safety of all students, FCPS reserves the right to prohibit the wearing of any jewelry during physical education class. Health classes will need a spiral notebook and pocket folder for portfolios.

Math: Graphing Calculator: TI-83 or TI-84 for Geometry or Algebra or a scientific for Pre-Algebra

Electives: Purchase only for the electives for which you are enrolled.

Art: Thick & thin black markers, pocket folder, sketchbook (available at the school store).

Foreign Language: 3-ring binder with dividers

Theatre Arts: 3-ring binder, index cards, 1 composition book

Band: string players: Essential Elements 2000 Book 2, 42 Chorales for Band arranged by Philip Gordon

Life Skills: A pocket folder and \$10 Life skill fee – take home sewing projects

Problem Solving: 3-ring binder and dividers
